

EAT AND DRINK



HOBARTICA

Head down to Hobart's waterfront, Australia's Gateway to Antarctica, to find the last outpost before you hit "The Ice." Like Antarctica itself, Hobartica is a meeting place for international cultures and polar traditions. Dive into Antarctic plunge pools, warm up in Finnish tent saunas, and chat with a phenomenal range of Antarcticans about the science and culture of our southern pole. After dark, warm up with a whisky or hot drink in the McHenry Distillery Antarctic Lounge and Observatory, catch a local jazz band, and peer through a telescope with an astronomer.
